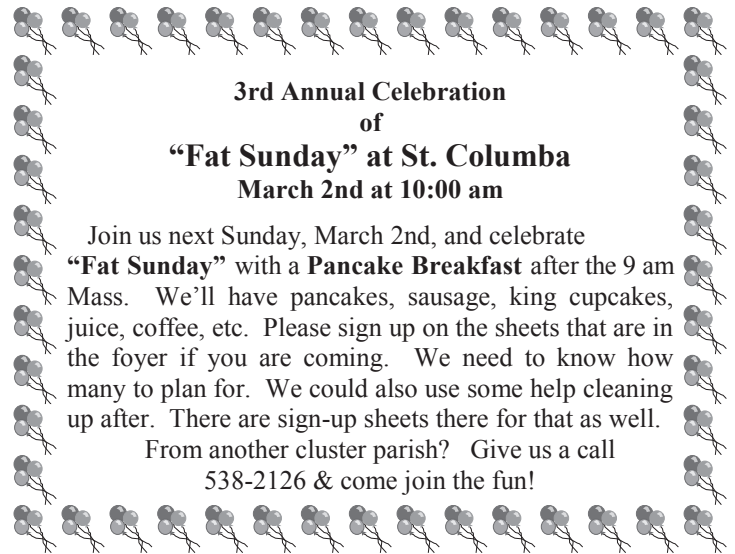
### Scottville Group Home Ministry

## Mary Doesn't Sing



Last Tuesday night the Cluster Pastoral Council met at St. Vincent's. Part of our discussion included how we have struggled to work towards making our Cluster Vision Statement closer to a reality. You may remember that five groups were formed. These included: Adult Faith Formation, Liturgy and Music, Stewardship, Youth, Evangelization and Communication. Some of these groups have been able to

accomplish more than others.. We also found that in some groups, such as Faith Formation, Liturgy and Youth we have paid staff continually working towards our goals.

After some discussion, the Council asked me for my bucket list of what I saw as important for our cluster. I rambled on for probably 15 minutes and they asked me to try to put some of my thoughts in the bulletin. These are just my thoughts from 30 years as a minister in the Rochester Diocese. Please also know that all of these efforts need to be in the context of prayer. They would and do mean nothing unless we are a community that gathers at least weekly for the Eucharist and prays daily for our church, our family and our world. Also these are not in any particular order of importance and they are often related.

I think of stewardship, which is a broad term. Stewardship is taking the gifts given by God, and sharing them with others. I have a strong belief that in Catholic parishes there is a wealth of gifts left dormant. I guess, as a person who felt they had no gifts to offer, I am grateful to those who let me know I had something to share. Just because I cannot sing, doesn't mean there aren't other things I can do. I believe in order for any parish to thrive we need to work and help each other find and share our gifts. This is not an easy task. In the book Rebuilt the authors tell us every person in a parish needs some job large or small. I think the closer we can get to that, the more vibrant we will be. Finding our place in a parish is not always easy. Again, I am a person who had to try, fail and try again. I found it difficult to find my place in a parish. Yet last week I received a note from Bishop Clark thanking me for my service. He wrote that I had the esteem of my colleagues, which included him. This to the introvert with no talents. In the weeks to come I will continue my *bucket* list on Evangelization and Justice.

By the way, we have a great Cluster Council wanting very much to work together for the good of all. If you see one of them, please thank them for their service.
