Mary Doesn't Sing

This weekend I continue my thoughts from our Cluster Council meeting and our endeavor to work on making our Cluster Vision Statement a reality. Another area of thought is justice. In my years as an administrator, I have hoped to create a group that looked at justice issues. When we look at social justice, we learn that there are two feet. One is **charity**, which includes providing people with food or shelter. Another area is **justice**. Justice includes asking why we need to provide food. It is about knowing that we can give a person a fish and he has a meal for a day. However, if we teach him or her how to fish, we provide a way of living. Justice asks what is it that causes some people to be without food or shelter. It then asks, can we do something about it? Our three churches have been very good at collecting and giving out food and money and other needs. As parishes we have not gone into areas and seen the real poverty so that we might ask the big question- why?

In the process of clarifying my thoughts for the Council, a new Lenten committee was forming. This committee was formed from the cluster liturgy committee. A suggestion came from a member to form committees around the different seasons of the liturgical year. This committee would look at the readings for the season, come up with a theme and provide some activity for the cluster. We decided to give it a try. To our amazement, it was amazing. A small group was formed from parishioners from each parish. We gathered, looked at readings, and had a wonderful discussion. Lo and behold, the area that kept coming up was hunger. We spent another meeting naming things we could do. In that meeting, we realized we were trying to solve all the problems at once.

Another thing we realized was, Lent is about change not about doing something wonderful and being done with it.

The committee decided on three evenings where there will be a

soup supper, prayer, and a speaker on hunger. Along with that, a committee was formed to write articles for the bulletin. You will note their articles by the symbols of the two feet of justice. These gatherings will be on Thursday evenings, March 13, 20 and April 10. We will begin with soup at 6 pm, prayer, and speaker at 7 pm. After Lent we will see where we go from there. I thank the following who said "yes" to this group: Nancy Kelly, Ellen Schulte, Sandy Preston, Pat and Brian Fleming, Sue Hayes, Sue Rountree, Jeanne Dudek and Colleen Trevisani.

Lenten Observance

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fasting and abstinence. All other Fridays during the season of Lent are days of abstinence.

Abstinence refers to not eating meat. All persons 14-59 years old are obliged to abstain.

Fasting refers to eating only one full meal a day. The other meals should have smaller portions that would not total a full meal. Adults 18-60 years old are obliged to fast.

Fast and Abstain on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstain on all other Fridays in Lent.
