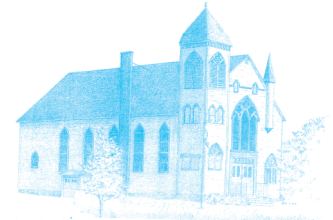

Mary Doesn't Sing

I continue my thoughts from last week. An area that the cluster parishes said was important was Evangelization. The problem we found, is that it is also a broad term and very much related to everything we do. Much evangelization happens each week and each day. It happens when someone wanders into our Mass after being away and we stop and welcome them. It happens on Sunday when we return home and talk to a family member who does not join us. We tell them how much being with the community meant to us. It happens Monday when you go to work, school or out to Wegmans. You stop, say hello to a friend or neighbor, they ask how your weekend was, and you tell what a gift it was to celebrate Eucharist with parishioners. Whenever we lift up the Catholic Church instead of putting it down, we evangelize.



Yes there are other ways also. We are always trying to reach our youth and young adults before going off into the world. That is what NCYC is about. This gives our high school youth a wonderful experience of their Catholic faith before leaving home. It is why the cluster has tried to keep a youth minister on our staff, even when few families wish to partake in youth events. As a group, I do not think we reach our young parents. Yes, we have baptism classes and then in five years there is Faith Formation for the child. I think we could do a better job of evangelization if we offered something on Christian Parenting. Being a new parent is exciting, but challenging. In the busyness, do we consider how can we pass on a vibrant faith in all we do? Most of our parents want to do the best they can and do everything possible for their children. Passing on faith is critical and yet, I am not sure it happens easily today. Let me know if you think that might be worth pursuing.

Related to evangelization is our project to unveil our new cluster website. Right now, we thought it would be nice to have a cluster logo. We have the images of our churches, both as pictures and as line drawings, and we have our symbols from each of the parishes processional crosses. We thought it might be nice to have one small symbol that represents the three parishes in our cluster. Any creative ideas? The website committee will have more information on this idea soon.

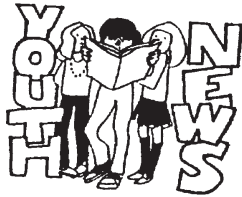
