April 6, 2014 5th Sunday of Lent



What a powerful way to spend three evenings in Lent. Dr. Joseph Kelly reminded us of the importance of being still in order to come to know our God. We remembered how Elijah hiding in a cave in fear went outside to find God. Elijah did not find God in the wind of the earthquake. He did not find God in the fire. Elijah found God in a tiny whispering sound.

We need to learn to be still so we too can find God in the whispering sound. Dr. Kelly gave us that time as we spent ten to fifteen minutes each night in silence. Each night there was 70 to 100 people and you could hear a pin drop in the silence. Did we hear God; perhaps, or perhaps as Dr. Kelly said it takes time to get to know this God of ours who comes to us as creator, redeemer and sanctifier.

A prayer for all of us as we close in on Holy Week that we each can find some time to be present to our Lord. You should be receiving an Easter letter soon; it will give you the opportunities to join our communities to be in prayer during Holy Week. Prayers for a beautiful conclusion to Lent for us all!

In November 2010, Pope Benedict XVI spoke of the ‘scandal of hunger’ that pervades our modern age. In For I Was Hungry and You Gave Me Food, the U.S. bishops reiterated that a primary goal of food and agricultural policy should be providing basic food and nutrition for all. In Food Policy in a Hungry World, the bishops called for strengthening the domestic food assistance programs to ensure that no one in America goes hungry or suffers malnutrition. “When the economy fails to provide jobs and income necessary to prevent hunger and malnutrition, the various local, state and national food assistance programs must be funded and expanded to provide food to all in need.”
