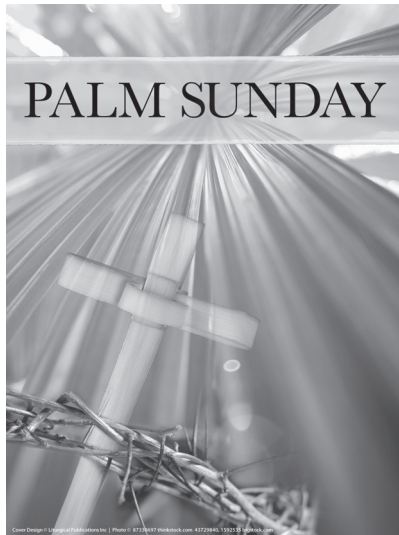

April 13, 2014 Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord



On this day we enter Holy Week. The liturgies of this week, especially the Triduum, are rich with the language of symbol and are shaped by scripture texts that engage the spiritual imagination. These liturgies call for a level of participation that is more engaging than most. We use gestures, processions, singing, silence and all our senses in order to experience the full depth of the mystery we enter. The Triduum is the heart of our liturgical year. During these three days (Sunset Thursday to Sunset Sunday) we enter into the mystery of divine love. Why not plan to join us for this one liturgy that begins on Thursday evening and ends with close of the Easter Vigil.

On Tuesday we celebrate the Chrism Mass at Sacred Heart Cathedral. At this liturgy the oils which will be used throughout the year are blessing. This year we make our complete cycle and Holy Thursday will be at St. Vincent's at 7pm. This first part of our liturgy

emphasizes the priesthood, Eucharist and the commandment to love. **In a gesture of love we are invited to have our feet washed. We do this and recommit ourselves to a life of love as Christ has given us an example. Please come prepared to have your feet washed.** This is a beautiful symbol of our commitment to serve Christ through others. Each parish will have adoration from 9 until 11 pm. St. Vincent's will close at 10 with Tenebrae. St. Mary's will close with Night Prayer at 11 pm. Friday we continue our liturgy at St. Mary's at 3 pm where we will focus on the reading of the Passion, adoration of the cross and communion. Check each parish for when the churches will be open for communal and private prayer during the three days. Then finally on Saturday at 8:30 pm we celebrate what the church calls "the mother of all vigils" at St. Columba's. During this wonderful liturgy, Melyssa Greene and Brianna Walworth will become New Christians through the Sacraments of Initiation. Joseph Maurici will enter into full communion with the Catholic Church.

We are very grateful this year that Fr. Bill Endres is able to help us on this our busiest day of the year, Easter Sunday. All three parishes will have Mass at 8 am and 10 am. They will be crowded, so please plan according. These really are wonderful days and there is nothing more exciting than the community gathered together to celebrate our high holy days. We want all our family present. Whatever happens, I pray we will all move over, squeeze together and be happy that we can celebrate as a family. Staffs and volunteers have been working very hard to make this a beautiful, spiritual Triduum for all of us.

This Holy Week keep in your prayers our cluster of parishes and Fr. John Hayes. On June 30 you will again move into another transition with **Fr. Hayes as your new pastor.** Fr. Hayes will write in this column after Easter.

Today we each take home a blessed palm. We take and place them near the cross or our Bible. They remind us that Lent is the slow coming of spring to the earth, the renewal of life. They are like the great "Hosanna" with which we hail the crucified and risen Lord. At some time when you arrive home place the Palm and pray alone or with family members:

(Make the sign of cross)

Leader: Hosanna in the highest! Blessed is he who comes
in the name of the Lord.

(All respond) Hosanna in the highest.

Leader: Blessed are you, God of Israel,
So rich in love and mercy.
Let these branches ever remind us of
Christ's triumph.
May we who bear them rejoice in his cross and sing
your praise forever and ever.

All: Amen.

Good Friday is a day of both fasting and abstinence.

Abstinence refers to not eating meat. All persons 14-59 years old are obliged to abstain.

Fasting refers to eating only one full meal a day. The other meals should have smaller portions that would not total a full meal. Adults 18-60 years old are obliged to fast.

Fast and Abstain on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstain on all other Fridays in Lent.

This month's showing has plenty of resurrection themes for discussion, as we'll present the highly acclaimed 2002 version of Alexandre Dumas' classic story, "The Count of Monte Cristo." James Cavaziel (who portrayed Jesus in "The Passion of the Christ" 2 years later) stars as Edmund Dantes, a sailor during Napoleonic times who is falsely accused of treason and sent away to prison on a remote island. While suffering hellish conditions, he befriends an elderly inmate (played by Richard Harris), who gives Dantes new hope in his plight and helps him to undergo a deep transformation, allowing him eventually to become a wealthy, successful "Count of Monte Cristo." The question becomes: Will Dantes seek out his betrayer for true justice or revenge? This film is rated PG-13 for some violence and mild sexual situations (no nudity).
