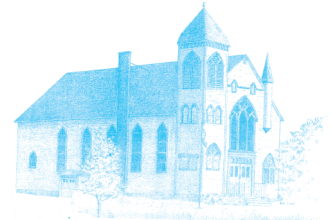

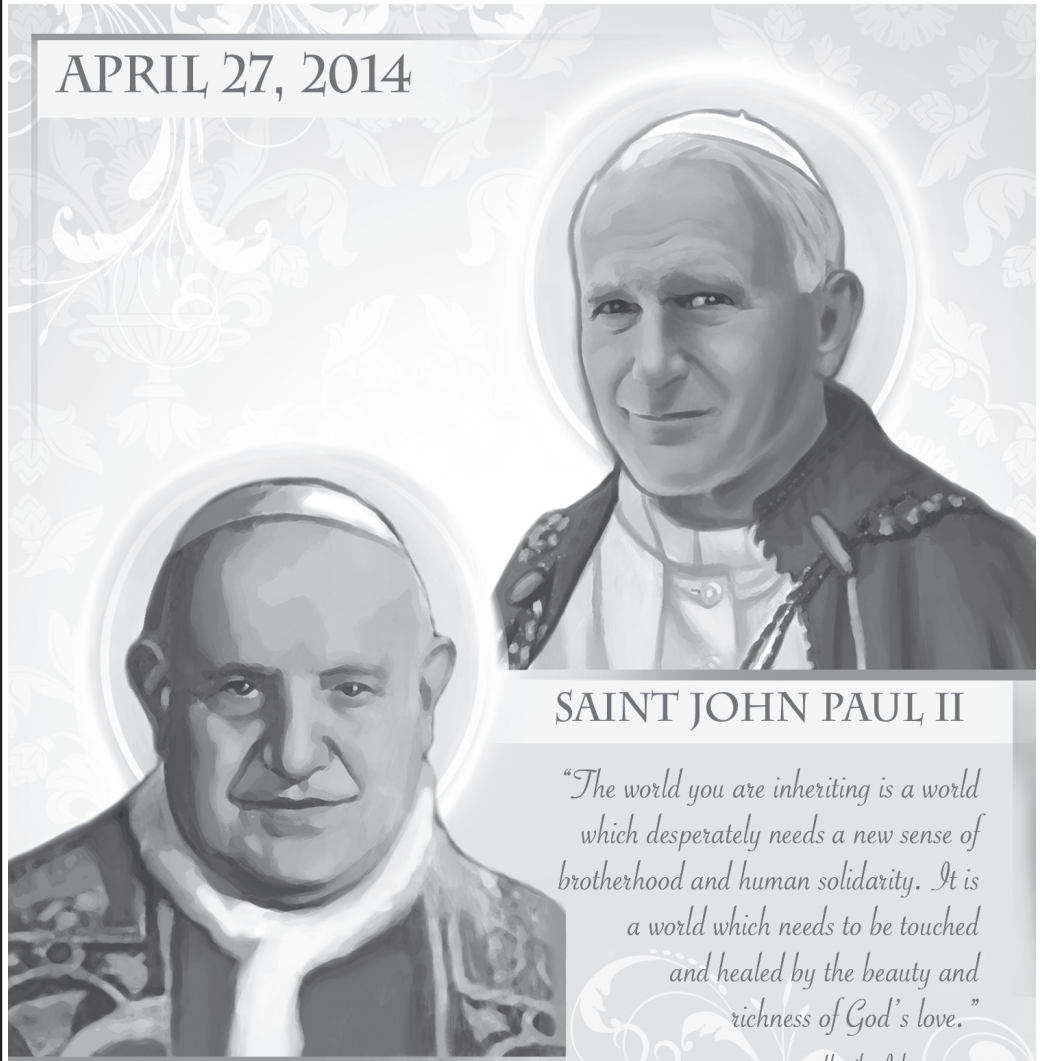

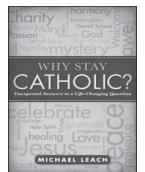
### Pre-baptism Class May 17
