This information has been provided by your Cemetery Advisory Board to help maintain Holy Angels in a way that will be respectful to our departed loved ones and remain a place of beauty and peace for all who come here to honor and pray for them.

Thank you for your conscientious observance of these few simple regulations.

Summer Decorations -
Fresh flowers may be placed on the graves in metal vases only.
Potted plants are not to exceed 8 inches in diameter.

- The cemetery is open from dawn to dusk for visiting purposes.
- Cemetery is carry in - carry out; there are no garbage cans provided.
- We have observed over the years that a small amount of grave decorations is most respectful.
- There are to be NO recreations vehicles in the Cemetery, ever. Parking is only allowed on the shoulder of the driveway.
- Planting is preferred on the front side of the monument.
- Planting of any kind on the sides or back of the monument will be allowed only as long as cared for by the family.
- Water is on and available May 1 through Oct 1 only. Please be advised- this water is not suitable for drinking.

Winter Decorations -
Holy Angels permits the placing of wreaths, natural or artificial, on graves from November 15- March 1.
Should a lot holder wish to save decorations, they should be removed prior to March 1.

Safety Considerations

Due to the risk of sharp objects being picked up by a mower/ trimmer and hurled in the air, which could injure a visitor or an employee, we insist that there be:

- NO CRUSHED STONE
- NO PLASTIC POTS OR VASES
- NO GLASS
- NO artificial flowers or ornaments or any kind are permitted.
- NO wooden or wire trellis or fence for flowers is permitted.

Should any monument or headstone become a danger, the Cemetery reserves the right to remove or correct the condition, upon notification of family.

Permanent plantings are not permitted in Holy Angels Cemetery. This includes any type of shrubs, bushes, trees, etc.
